He has been and continues as a professor of Sacred Liturgy at Immaculata University and Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary. He has lectured on the Sacred Liturgy throughout the country and recently published the book, *Music in Catholic Liturgy: A Pastoral and Theological Companion to Sing to the Lord*.
