Her books include her critically acclaimed journalistic study, *The New Faithful*, and her award-winning spiritual memoir, *My Sisters the Saints*. Her keynote session is entitled *Love Comes First: Lessons from the Women Saints*. She will also be giving a workshop presentation entitled *Wounded Healers: Finding Grace in the Burdens of Caregiving*.



Sister Mary Elizabeth entered the Sisters of Life community in 1993. She has served as Postulant Director, Novice Director, Director of the Family Life-Respect Life Office for the Archdiocese of New York and currently as the Vicar General for the community.

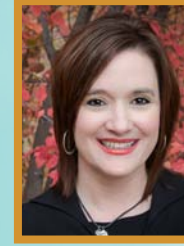

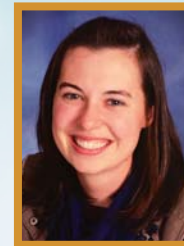
Workshop Speakers



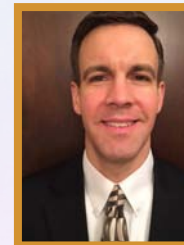

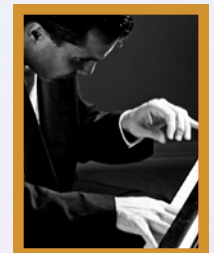
